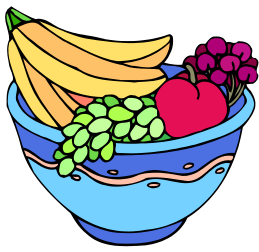
A free will donation will be accepted to help raise funds for the chapter and to help with the cost of the supper.
